SCHOLARSHIP AWARD:

James A. FitzPatrick Scholarships are sponsored by the Plattsburgh State College Foundation and The William H. Miner Agricultural Research Institute. Several \$1500 scholarships are available for residential students enrolled in the SUNY Plattsburgh Applied Environmental Science Program at Miner Institute. Students must meet the following criteria and submit an application to the Center for Earth and Environmental Science in Hudson Hall room 132.

ELIGIBILITY TO APPLY:

- Must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5
- Must be enrolled in a minimum of 12 credit hours of coursework or independent research at Miner Institute (enrollment in ENV 340 on campus can count toward this).
- Must elect to reside at Miner Institute's student housing complex.

ELIGIBILITY TO APPLY:

- Enroll in ENV 440 - Agriculture and the Environment (3 credits of 12 required)
- Enroll in a minimum of 12 credits in the Fall Applied Environmental Science Program (AESP)
- Reside at Miner Institute's student housing complex and participate in Miner meal plan
- Minimum GPA = 2.5

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS DURING PROGRAM:

- Perform a 1-credit guided study program on a topic pertaining to agriculture's influence on society and the environment culminating in a professional 30-minute powerpoint presentation as part of the Agriculture and the Environment course.

Deadline to apply is April 15, 2014. Scholarship recipients will be notified by May 10, 2014.
